Contingency Planning for COVID 19 Outbreaks

As a school we have identified and planned for two possible scenarios which may cause disruption to the continuity of pupils' education. For the school academic year 2021-22, the school will plan for the following.

Scenario One A – Individual required to self-isolate: 10 Days Absence

If a child or member of staff is required to self-isolate after being tested positive for Covid – 19 but are well enough to learn from home.

The pupil will be given a device, if needed, and be expected to log on to access their timetable of teaching. The pupil will access the live streaming via their office 365 accounts. Where parental support may be limited due to illness, minimum expectation is that the pupil will access the live teaching for reading, writing and maths.

The principles for delivery, for Scenario Two, will be as follows:

- > Children will have a consistent weekly timetable, covering a broad range of subjects.
- ➤ Learning will be sequenced as per our current curriculum model.
- > To prevent lost learning, all lessons will be live streamed to and include high quality direct instruction and regular checks on understanding
- Independent practice will be recorded in the pupil's 'Home Learning Log'. On return to school this will be required to be submitted to the class teacher.
- Lessons will be of the equivalent length of a normal school day.
- > Bespoke Sways will be produced for children who have special educational needs.
